Job description

- Proactively coordinate and communicate with key internal stakeholders in corporate IT security governance functions and other departments.

Qualifications

Minimum qualifications:

- Computer Science / Telecommunications Engineering Degree or related discipline.
- Two years of experience in IT security and performing IT security audits and penetration tests.
- Good understanding of Cybersecurity landscape and Cybersecurity threats.
- Familiarity with programming and scripting languages like Python, Powershell and C#
- Knowledge of security methodologies like OWASP, OWISAM and OSSTMM.
- Familiarity with security tools like Burp Suite, Acunetix, Nessus and Qualys.
- Good communication and presentation skills.
- Results oriented attitude.
- Self-motivated with the ability to work independently and as a team member in a challenging environment.
- Intermediate English level (written and spoken).

Ideal qualifications:

- Knowledge of advanced techniques and attacks related to MITRE ATT&CK (persistence, privilege escalation, defense evasion, lateral movement, exfiltration).
- Knowledge of public cloud architectures (AWS, Azure, GCP).
